

Pre or Post Trib Rapture

2Cor 13:1 ... In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established.

2Peter 1:20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation (*scripture interprets scripture*)

1Cor 10:11 Now all these things happened unto them (*Israel in the wilderness*) for ensamples (*lesson*): and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.

Ecc 1:9 The thing that hath been, it is that which shall be; and that which is done is that which shall be done: and there is no new thing under the sun.

Rapture and resurrection at the same time?

1The 4:13 But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. **14** For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. **15** For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive [and] remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. **16** For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: **17** Then we which are alive [and] remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

1Cor 15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, **52** In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

The Last Trump:

The fourth (last) trump on the feast of trumpets – takia HagAdolah

Rev 10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

Rev 11:15 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become [the kingdoms] of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

When will the resurrection take place?

1Cor 15:20 But now is Christ risen from the dead, [and] become the firstfruits of them that slept. **21** For since by man [came] death, by man [came] also the resurrection of the dead. **22** For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive. **23** But every man in his own order: **Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming.** **24** Then [cometh] the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.

Act 2:34 For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, **35** Until I make thy foes (enemies) thy footstool.

Act 3:20 And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: **21** Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

John 6:39 And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. **40** And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day. **44** No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.

Mat 24:29 Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken: **30** And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

Mat 24:31 And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Mar 13:27 And then shall he send his angels, and shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of heaven.

Mar 13:24 But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, 25 And the stars of heaven shall fall, and the powers that are in heaven shall be shaken. 26 And then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great power and glory.

Job 14:12 So man lieth down, and riseth not: till the heavens [be] no more, they shall not awake, nor be raised out of their sleep. 13 O that thou wouldest hide me in the grave, that thou wouldest keep me secret, until thy wrath be past, that thou wouldest appoint me a set time, and remember me! 14 If a man die, shall he live [again]? all the days of my appointed time will I wait, till my change come.

Rev 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and [I saw] the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received [his] mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. 5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This [is] the first resurrection. 6 Blessed and holy [is] he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. 14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

Rev 7:9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands; 13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they? 14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Isa 26:16 LORD, in trouble have they visited thee, they poured out a prayer [when] thy chastening [was] upon them. 17 Like as a woman with child, [that] draweth near the time of her delivery, is in pain, [and] crieth out in her pangs; (Rev 12, John 16:21) so have we been in thy sight, O LORD. 18 We have been with child, we have been in pain, we have as it were brought forth wind (Spirit); we have not wrought any deliverance in the earth; neither have the inhabitants of the world fallen. 19 Thy dead [men] shall live, [together with] my dead body shall they arise. Awake and sing, ye that dwell in dust: for thy dew [is as] the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead. 20 Come, my people, enter thou into thy chambers, and shut thy doors about thee: hide thyself as it were for a little moment, until the indignation (wrath) be overpast. (Noah's Ark)

Dan 9:27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, ...

Dan 12:1 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation [even] to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book. 2 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame [and] everlasting contempt.

Dan 12:6 ... How long [shall it be to] the end of these wonders? 7 [it shall be] for a time, times, and an half; and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the holy people, all these [things] shall be finished. 11 And from the time [that] the daily [sacrifice] shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, [there shall be] a thousand two hundred and ninety days. (1290 days) (lunar calendar - add one month [30 days] every 3 years) (Rev 11:3, 12:6 1260 days, solar calendar). 12 Blessed [is] he that waiteth, and cometh to the thousand three hundred and five and thirty days (1335 days).

Dan 12:13 But go thou thy way till the end [be]: for thou shalt rest, and stand in thy lot at the end of the days.

Do the Old Covenant saints have a different resurrection than the New Covenant believers? (Not according to these verses)

Romans 11 (the whole chapter) Gentiles are grafted into their vine and we all partake of the same root.

Gal 3:7 Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham.

Gal 3:16 Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, and to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ.

Jesus gathers his elect twice.

Where does the bible say he will come in the clouds before the 7 year tribulation? (Which would make 3 times)

1st time:

Mat 24:29 Immediately after the tribulation ... 30 ... and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. **31** And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Mar 13:24 But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, 25 And the stars of heaven shall fall, and the powers that are in heaven shall be shaken. 26 And then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great power and glory. 27 And then shall he send his angels, and shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of heaven.

2nd time

Isa 11:11 (*All of Isaiah 11 is describing the 1000 year millennial reign of Christ*) And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] the Lord shall set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria, and from Egypt, and from Pathros, and from Cush, and from Elam, and from Shinar, and from Hamath, and from the islands of the sea.

Foreshadows of the tribulation

Joshua 6:1-25 Battle of Jerico. Rahab the harlot, foreshadow of church, lineage of Jesus, Math 1:5

Genesis 7 - Noah and the ark (Jesus)

Genesis 19:15-30 - Lot taken out of Sodom

Isaiah 32: 9-20 -

Exodus 12:15 seven days of unleavened bread

Leviticus 23:35-36 Feast of Tabernacles - Holy convocation 8th day,

Tribulation

Mat 7:14 **Because** strait [is] the gate, and narrow (Greek: thlibo) [is] the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

- **2Cr 7:5** For, when we were come into Macedonia, our flesh had no rest, but we were troubled (thlibo) on every side; without [were] fightings, within [were] fears.
- **1Th 3:4** For verily, when we were with you, we told you before that we should suffer tribulation; (thlibo) even as it came to pass, and ye know.
- **Hbr 11:37** They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted (**thlibo**), tormented;

Jhn 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation; (thlipsis) but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

Act 14:22 Confirming the souls of the disciples, [and] exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation (thlipsis) enter into the kingdom of God.

Jam 1:12 Blessed [is] the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.

1Pe 4:12 Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try (Greek: temptations) you, as though some strange thing happened unto you:

Deu 4:30 When thou art in tribulation, and all these things are come upon thee, [even] in the latter days, if thou turn to the LORD thy God, and shalt be obedient unto his voice;

Dan 12:1 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation [even] to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.

Mat 24:15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:) **16** Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains: **17** Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house: **18** Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes. **19** And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days! **20** But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day: **21** For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.

Why God sends tribulation to saints (stony ground hearers):

Isa 26:9 With my soul have I desired thee in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek thee early: for when thy judgments [are] in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness.

Mat 13:21 Yet hath he not root in himself, but dureth for a while: for when tribulation (thlipsis) or persecution ariseth because of the word, by and by he is offended (falls away).

Rom 5:3 And not only [so], but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience:

2Cr 4:17 For our light affliction (thlipsis - tribulations), which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding [and] eternal weight of glory:

2Cr 6:4 But in all [things] approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions (thlipsis - tribulations), in necessities, in distresses,

Scriptures used to by some to support Pre-trib

Revelation 3:10 " I will keep thee from the **hour** of Temptation..." (not seven days, 7 years or seven time)

1 Thessalonians 1:10 "delivered us from the **wrath** to come..." (Day of the Lord, not tribulation)

1 Thessalonians 5:9 "God hath not appointed us to **wrath**..." (Day of the Lord, not tribulation)

Luke 21:34 – 36 "accounted worthy to escape the **wrath** to come..." (Day of the Lord, not tribulation)

Mal. 3:16 – 18 "... in that **day**...I will spare them as a man spareth his own son..." (Day of the Lord, not tribulation)

II Peter 2:5 "Saved Noah, but brought the flood upon the world of the ungodly" (Noah in the ark 1 year (day) not 7)

II Peter 2:9 "the Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations and to reserve the unjust unto the **day** of judgment to be punished..." (Day of the Lord, not days of tribulation)

Romans 8:1 "No **condemnation** to those that are in Christ Jesus..." (No condemnation, yes tribulation)

Daniel 9:24 "Seventy weeks are determined upon **thy** people..." (According to Romans 11, believers are **THY** people)

(Great) Day of the Lord, Day of wrath, Wrath of God, Day of God

8th day (year) after 7 days (years) of tribulation

Jesus name in Greek adds up to 888 (ΙΗΣΟΥΣ =10+8+200+70+400+200 = 888)

Feast of Tabernacles - Holy convocation 8th day, Leviticus 23:35

Circumcision - Gen 17:12

Isa 34:2-8 For [it is] the **day of the LORD'S vengeance**, [and] the year of recompenses for the controversy of Zion.

Isa 63:1-6 (4) For the **day of vengeance** [is] in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come.

1Th 5:9 For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,

Rev 14:9 ... If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive [his] mark in his forehead, or in his hand,

10 The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:
